

Port Lavaca, Texas

Port Lavaca, Texas is seeking a new City Manager. The City of Port Lavaca is located 75 miles northeast of Corpus Christi, 130 miles southwest of Galveston, and 25 miles south of Victoria. With a population on 12,003, as the County seat for Calhoun County, approximately 20,000 vehicles travel daily on Highway 35 passing through town.

Port Lavaca is a home rule city with a Council-Manager form of government. The City has 84 full-time and 6 part-time employees and provides an array of services including public work, parks, finance, human resources, municipal court, building inspection and port operations. The Police Department with 20 employees oversees the Animal Control Division. The Fire Department has 17 employees and a volunteer group of 8 employees. Port Lavaca has an annual 2013-2014 budget of \$15 million.

The selected candidate should have a bachelor's degree in public administration, business administration, or a related field, and three to five years' experience as a City Manager in a comparable city, or as an Assistant City Manager or Department/Division Director in a comparable size or larger community. Municipal government experience is required. A master's degree is preferred and credentials as a Certified Public Manager are highly desired. (Current enrollment will be considered).
