## CONSIDER AWARD OF BID FOR 2016-2017 FY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (CIP) THE BONORDEN ADDITION STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Public Works Director Pena advised Council the Bonorden Addition Street Reconstruction is part of the 2016-2017 Capital Improvement Project (CIP) that was budgeted for the current 2016-2017 Fiscal Year. He said the original bid opening was scheduled for August 29, 2017; however, due to hurricane Harvey, the bid opening was delayed until September 14, 2017. CivilCorp and staff opened bids for the project and received bids from Lester Construction, Brannan Paving Co., Inc. and Jimmy Evans Company and bid tabulation is as follows:
